CONGREGATIONAL CARE

UMC UPDATE: I wanted to update you on how the UMC is moving forward in dealing with the issue of full inclusion for our LGBTQ+ siblings, which we have been debating for over 40 years. Since a regressive General Conference in 2019, the church has been on the brink of schism. Initially we were advancing a Protocol for Reconciliation and Grace through Separation, which would keep the UMC intact and allow local churches to determine their own position and practices regarding full inclusion. A special General Conference was scheduled in 2020 to consider this, but cancelled during the pandemic. Since then, the Traditionalists, those opposed to full inclusion in the church, agreed to separate and form their own denomination called the Global Methodist Church. There are financial incentives for this separation, but so far, no decisions have been made, and it is still unclear if General Conference will meet as planned in Minneapolis next September. What is clear that a formal separation is likely inevitable (and welcome to many of us) and the UMC will remain in some form, without those opposed to the full inclusion of our LGBTQ+ sisters and brothers. I will keep you posted as events unfold.

Members of this team have medical or mental health training. If there is a medical emergency, if needed, this person will respond appropriately and take the lead to call 911. We understand that, perhaps, the person experiencing difficulty would prefer not have attention called to them and not to have 911 contacted but it is important, both for the well-being of the person and insurance purposes that the Worship Care Team have the ability and authority to make that call. If someone is experiencing emotional distress, this person will also reach out to provide care. If, during worship, you or someone could use help from the Sunday Worship Care Team member, please reach out to them.
